The Clean, Green and Safe Committee, meet on Tuesday, June 2, 2009 at 9 am at the Wicker Park Bucktown Chamber office.

- **Christmas Decorations:**
 - Review multiple vendors and their options. There was only one vendor that provides rental, maintenance and storage of the decorations. The Clean, Green and Safe Committee are requesting a RFP from, A division of HAP Industries.
 - Jason and David have been started to inventory which light poles will be used for the decorations.
- **Implementation of recycling cans.**
 - **Motion 1**
 - The Clean, Green and Safe Committee request funding to install 10 recycling cans at a cost of \$3,600 from Line item number 3.05. This will complete the recycling pilot project started by Dan two years ago.
- **Update on Tree pits and tree pruning**
 - Jason meets with Kelly from Christy Weber for weekly updates.
 - Christy Weber has installed gator bags on trees that are 2" and less in diameter. They will fill as needed.
 - Researching a possible pilot program to put resin base mulch in tree pits. The pilot project would be tested on 10 tree pits. This would be the removal and replacement of any dead trees, old mulch, and installation of the resin base mulch. We are also looking into a third party to monitor the success of the pilot project.
- **Futura Update.**
 - Met with Futura in May to finalize needed fields for the database.
 - Next meeting in June. Futura will be bringing an alpha copy of the database for our review.
- **Street Cleaning Contract**
 - Sent RFP to Clean Slate for 2010 contract. We have requested that Clean Slate add more days of service in the summer and reduce same number of days of service in the winter.
- **Update Vest and or Magnetic signs have been ordered.**
- **Snow Removal**
 - Sent RFP's to 3 providers. Jason is working with the Belmont /Central Chamber of Commerce on these RFP's. We are hoping this will help reduce pricing.
- **Multin Court**
 - Restaurant has provided flowers in the front tree planters.
 - There are no public trash cans in Multin Court. Jason contracted Street and Sanitation to see if they can provide trash cans. Streets and Sanitation will look into this.
- **Painting of tree pit fences on Division Street**
 - RFP's have been sent and received with prices from \$6,000 to \$20,000 to wire brush, primer and paint 71 tree pit fences.
 - The vendor we have selected is Shorty's L.L.C.
 - **Motion 2**
 - The Clean, Green and Safe Committee request funding for the painting of tree pit fences on Division Street at total cost of \$6,000 from Line item 3.05.
