The Clean, Green and Safe Committee, met on Tuesday, October 06, 2009 at 9 am at Janik's Cafe.

- **Christmas Decorations Update:**
  - HAP Industries has started the installation of brackets on light pole to support the snow flakes and banners.
  - Requesting for Hap to keep lights on trees till April, to reduce damage to trees branches which can be broken during the removal process.
  - City of Chicago has agreed to install electrical feed in the Polish Triangle.
  - Work with Christy Webber to trim trees in the Polish Triangle.
  - Ice sculptures at Mautene Court will consist of the Tower, Polar Bear and Penguins.
- **Futurity Update.**
  - Setting a meeting date for next steps and planning on how Jason and Kelly from Christy Webber will start working together.
- **Christy Weber Monthly Update**
  - Gator bags have been removed
  - Fall pruning and replacing mulch as needed to start in September
  - Tree pits on Western, Milwaukee and Ashland have been dug to a depth of 4" and replaced with new mulch.
- **CleanSlate Update**
  - Street cleaning contract is being reviewed by CleanSlate lawyers
- **Olsen Inc. Update**
  - Snow removal contract is being reviewed by Olsen lawyers
- **Division St. Fences**
  - Working with CDOT to resolve ownership issues. If this is not resolved within the next few weeks, the fences will not be painted this year.
- **Graffiti Abatement Program**
  - Preparing an RFQ for the new marketing materials
- **Commercial Recycling Program**
  - Prepared a survey that we will be taking to the businesses on Division, between Damen and Western and Damen, between North and the Bloomingdale trail.
- **Pilot Program Recycle Containers Assessment**

- CleanSlate has provided Jason with details on the use of these containers.
- **Trash Receptacles**
  - Motion 1
    - Motion to approve \$3000 for the purchase of a minimum of 15 trash receptacles, plastic inserts, locks and chains for receptacles to be placed on Damen Ave. and other locations within the WPB. This would be in support of both 1<sup>st</sup> and 32<sup>nd</sup> Wards Streets and Sanitations Superintendents.
- **Apply for Recycling Grant Money**
  - Discussed possibly applying for a Traditional Recycling Collection and Processing, Illinois Recycling Grant Program, grant for recycling receptacles DCEO(Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity, Bureau of Energy and Recycling), and SSA to match funding. This would help fund additional trash recycling cans.
