

Motion 1. Promotional items. To allocate \$3,300 for purchase of lights and reflective accessories to use as promotional items for nighttime safety (by police and at events like Bike to Work Week and bike valet stations), and to sponsor a coffee break for a winter bicycle tour of the neighborhood. We expect these items to reach approximately 1,000 cyclists over the course of the year.

Motion 2. Voting members. Expect to add Katie Call and Brandon Antoniewicz as voting members of the committee.

Suggestion. For the Project of the Year, we would suggest that committees focus additional effort on improvements around Milwaukee/Bloomington/Leavitt, in conjunction with plans for development of a new park there.

Next meeting. 10 March 2010, 7PM.

2011 budget recommendation. An amount for bike valet services, \$18K for advocacy/promotions/bike racks, and \$2000 for safety materials.
